Grape : 100% Albariño – Albariño is a white grape variety from Galicia (northwestern Spain) and northern Portugal.

Vinification: Traditionally vinified by direct pressing. Carefully protected by cold.

Discover this luminous cuvée, made from the Albariño grape variety, present on the estate since 2018. It embodies the freshness and liveliness of the Mediterranean terroir.

Its pale yellow color with silver highlights heralds a delicate nose. The aromas are frank and precise; lemon zest, hints of yellow plum, and subtle notes of nuts. The palate is chiseled, lively, and energetic.

It's a true breath of fresh air that will accompany the entire tasting.

Aging: Pleasant to drink immediately upon bottling.

Food and wine pairing: A wine to enjoy with a seafood platter, or veal tartare with capers and lemon zest.
